General Fire Provisions – Town of Fulford

Updated July, 2020

- The Town of Fulford has erected a building that houses a pumper fire truck that holds 300 gallons of water. Hoses and nozzles on this truck are checked annually and replaced as needed. The truck is available for use from June through September each year. Written instructions are laminated and in the truck.
- The Town of Fulford fire truck building also contains emergency oxygen and defib equipment. The building is accessible to anyone in town.
- The Town of Fulford also has a fire-fighting pumper trailer that remains on the
 western side of town from June through September. The water holding capacity of
 this trailer is 600 gallons and is towable by any vehicle with a trailer hitch.
 Instructions are laminated and accompany the trailer.
- The Town of Fulford, at its annual picnic in July, executes fire truck training as well as fire trailer training for interested property owners.
- The Town of Fulford, at its annual picnic in July, is briefed by the US Forest Service on Fire Safety, brush clearing around cabins, and current fire danger status.
- The Town of Fulford has positioned throughout town fire hose boxes that are tied into the main water system for the town. Each fire hose box contains a 50 ft., 1 1/2 inch hose, nozzle, and key to turn the water on. These fire hose boxes are accessible to anyone and are not locked.
- The Town of Fulford has a strong working relationship with The Eagle County Fire and Rescue Department and consults with them on a regular basis regarding elements of making the town more fire safe.
- The Town of Fulford does not have an official fire department nor do we have fire personnel. We supply basic equipment to enable property owners the opportunity to slow or hold a fire at bay until the fire dept arrive. The use of this equipment is up to the property owners with no guarantees from the town.
